



**City of Colton Electric Utility
Colton Public Benefit Charge Credit Form**

City ordinance Number R-123-97 established a Public Benefit Charge of \$0.0029 per Kilowatt-hour to collect revenues for Public Benefit programs: Cost effective demand-side management services to promote energy efficiency and conservation. New investment in renewable energy sources and technologies. Research, development, and demonstration to advance science or technology. Services for low-income electricity customers including targeted energy efficiency and rate discounts. The City of Colton adopted a resolution on February 3, 1998 (R-07-98) that provides a Public Benefit Charge Credit of 100% of the Public Benefit Charge for income eligible households.

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for the Public Benefit Charge Credit, your total combined household income must be below the following limits:
